*The Beach House is only available for the May 11-14 workshop and not the pre-conference workshop. Pre-conference accommodations are at the Francis Marion Hotel. If you are staying for both workshops, feel free to switch to the Beach House on Tuesday 11th following the Food is Elementary workshop.

THE BEACH HOUSE ON FOLLY ISLAND* (May 11-14 –inclusive)

We host our workshop at a luxurious ocean front beach house on Folly Island, a short 15 minutes from downtown Charleston. We have 5 beautiful bedroom suites available on a first come, first serve basis. The house is literally on the beach, with a private path to the sand and ocean. **If you wish to wake up next to the ocean**, this option is for you. A room at the house entitles you to the full run of the house, including the kitchen and all amenities.

\$149-per night (all inclusive taxes): Queen with full bath

\$169 per night (All inclusive taxes): Luxury master suite with sitting room and full bath

\$89/night/person (all inclusive taxes): Shared room (2 double beds) with half bath (shower)

Add: \$30 (total) or \$7.95/day/person for 4 full breakfasts (fresh fruit, yogurts, local baked delicacies, etc.)

FRANCIS MARION HOTEL – CHARLESTON ** (For pre-conference and/or conference lodging)

For the pre-workshop program and the full workshop, we have reserved a room block at the historic Francis Marion hotel in downtown Charleston. The Francis Marion Hotel, located in the heart of historic Charleston, South Carolina, was the largest and grandest in the Carolinas when it opened in 1924. Named for [General Francis Marion, the "Swamp Fox"](#) of the American Revolution, the Francis Marion Hotel in Charleston re-opened in 1996 after a \$12 million National Trust award-winning restoration, and is once again Charleston's Grand Hotel.
